Course Description:

These courses are designed to meet the Archdiocesan Math Standards for grades 7-8

Numeration/Number Sense

Integers, real numbers, irrational numbers, rational numbers, absolute values, ratios, proportions, percents, powers, square roots, properties

Computation/Estimation

Order of operations, fractions, problem solving techniques

Measurement and Data

Quantities involving capacity, weight/mass in standard and metric units, solve problems using rates

Geometry/Spatial Concepts

Two-dimensional figures, plane figures, perimeter, circumference, surface area, area, volume

Data Analysis, Probability, Statistical Concepts

Graphical representations, samples, populations, probability

Algebraic Concepts

Expressions, equations, inequalities, graphing on a one and two dimensional coordinate plane, solving one and two step equations involving variables

Assignments:

Homework is an important part in learning and mastering math concepts. Daily assignments will given to aid in this process. A student's quarterly grade will be determined by dividing the student's total points earned by the total possible points for that quarter. Daily assignments will be worth 5-10 points, quizzes will be worth 20-30 points and tests will be worth 40-60 points.
